Two ULARP members have recently been recognized in UofL events and publications because of their contributions to the university. <u>Leo B. Jenkins</u>, one of the founding members of ULARP, has been honored as the 2023 J. B. Speed School of Engineering Alumni Fellow, and Mary Rising, A&S/ Mathematics and ULARP president 2018-23, is spotlighted in the <u>fall 2023 UofL</u> <u>Magazine</u>, p.21, the first retiree spotlight planned as a regular feature in the magazine, one of several new initiatives that the university has undertaken to affirm retirees as a recognized constituency.

Another important initiative is preparation for an annual "Distinguished Retiree Excellence in Scholarship/ Community Service Award" to parallel awards for distinguished faculty and staff performance. Award criteria are now under discussion with the Office of the President and will be circulated in time for 2025 award nominations.

In Your Spare Time, Consider Going to Class

In 1976, the General Assembly approved <u>free tuition for</u> <u>any Kentucky citizen 65 or older</u> at any state institution. Those wishing to use the benefit must be admitted to the institution, and they must be 65 years old on the first day of class with a Kentucky state ID (Indiana residents are not eligible). At UofL, persons eligible and enrolled are eligible to join a recognized student organization, Donovan Scholars, which provides social, academic and advocacy support during enrollment.
